The Salmagundi Club is one of the oldest professional art societies in America. The mission of Salmagundi is to inspire originality in the artists and patrons among its members and to advance art of all types. Included in this objective is the aim of encouraging the appreciation of art by the public through all available means – education, exhibits, demonstrations, and lectures – providing a place for artist members where they can meet on a professional level.

Mission Statement:

The Salmagundi Club, as a center for American Art, is a tax-exempt, educational, and charitable organization. Housed in a historic building that is ideally located on Fifth Avenue and Twelfth Street, at the nexus of Soho, Chelsea, and the Village, Salmagundi offers year-round programs including frequent art exhibitions, lectures, art classes, and demonstrations for members, their families, and friends.

As an Artist Member you have numerous opportunities throughout the year to exhibit your work, including the Spring and Fall Auction Exhibitions, that are mutually beneficial to the artist and the Club.

At Salmagundi, creators of art and friends of art come together for enjoyment, relaxation, and social activities, bound by a shared pleasure in the traditions of American Art.

Hours of admission to the public: Monday through Sunday from 1:00 to 5:00 PM free of charge.

MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION



Dear Applicant,

Salmagundi was founded in 1871 by a group of visionary painters and sculptors who saw that it was vitally important to help the broader American public toward a greater appreciation of art. The founders organized exhibitions and invited gallery owners and art collectors to view their different styles of painting. As the 19th century closed, Salmagundi played a leading role in acquainting Americans with the Impressionist movement that had been created in France where many Salmagundians had gone to study.

The tradition continues with year-round exhibitions that are free of charge to the public. These exhibitions typically include more than one-hundred works of art in varying media, including but not limited to painting, sculpture, and photography. The majority of our exhibitions are juried with the works available for sale within the not-for-profit framework.

The camaraderie for which Salmagundi is famous also extends into the social sphere. Dining at reasonable cost, entertaining and educational events, as well as other activities abound within our walls. The nostalgic atmosphere of old New York is palpable as one enters the doorway at 47 Fifth Avenue.

To become a member, complete the attached form and submit it with your check for \$200 covering your application fee. Please make your check out to "The Salmagundi Club." Keep in mind that if you wish to enter as an "Artist" membership candidate, you must submit 8-10 samples of your work via email. Careful consideration will be given to your application and because of this, we ask for your patience as this process takes several months.

MEMBERSHIP CLASSIFICATIONS

ARTIST MEMBER

(Resident or Non-Resident) applies to qualified practitioners of the visual arts.

PATRON MEMBER

(Resident or Non-Resident) applies to supporters and those interested in the arts.

JUNIOR MEMBER

(Resident Artist or Patron) applies to those who are between the ages of 21 and 34.

SCHOLARSHIP MEMBER

(Resident Artist only) between the ages of 21 and 30.

MEMBER SPOUSE

(For all categories) has all the social privileges of the Club, but may not exhibit artwork.

MEMBER BENEFITS

All categories...

- Enjoy delicious meals in the Dining Room and Bar at reasonable prices;
- Attend members' receptions and events;
- Exhibit artworks in many exhibitions throughout the year (Artist Members);
- Attend lectures and demonstrations;
- Become eligible for prizes and awards (Artist Members);
- Enjoy our fine arts Library with rare first editions;
- Host your own catered events at member-discounted rates;
- Engage in conversation and fellowship with artists and those who love art.

MEMBERSHIP DUES SCHEDULE

RESIDENT ARTIST AND PATRON \$1,050.00

Dues are billed quarterly at \$262.50 in January, April, July, and October. Minimum house restaurant charges* are computed at \$50.00 per quarter.

NON-RESIDENT ARTIST AND PATRON \$545.62

Dues are billed semi-annually at \$272.81 in January and July. There are no minimum house charges for this category.

JUNIOR ARTIST AND PATRON \$305.00

The application fee is waived.

Dues are billed quarterly at \$76.25 in January, April, July, and October. Minimum house restaurant charges* are computed at \$15.00. Junior members will become full Resident/Non-Resident members on his or her 35th birthday.

SCHOLARSHIP ARTIST ONLY

There are no dues for the first year and the application fee is waived. For the second year dues are \$32.00, the third year \$62.00, and the fourth year \$90.00. At the end of the fourth year, a Scholarship Member may continue at the rate of \$120.00 per year until his or her 31st birthday. Scholarship Members also do not have to pay the \$200 application fee.

MEMBER SPOUSE \$275.00

Dues are billed quarterly for Resident Spouses at \$68.75. Non-Resident Spouses are billed bi-annually.

Junior and Scholarship spouses will be charged the same fees as their spouse members. Member spouses for all categories are exempt from minimum house/bar charges. Non-member spouses may have signing privileges, and charges will be billed to the member's account.

** Minimum house charges are billed if you do not use the restaurant or bar.*
